## CHEMISTRY 100 LABS

You will do a lab most weeks. Be sure to read the lab before the class - it will really help. I mark each lab out of 5 for content and 5 for appearance. If you see "5,4" on a report, it means 5 for content and 4 for appearance. Make sure you hand in the lab on time (when you arrive at the lab) or you will lose a mark. Don't arrive at the lab, and then try to write up the report. I'll see you, and I'll knock off a mark.

To get credit for 100, you must get more than 50% for the labs.

While in the lab, you MUST wear safety glasses. They are on sale in the Bookstore and other places. Please do not forget to bring your glasses to the lab. If you do forget, you might not be able to do the lab.

I keep attendance in the lab - in the past students who have not actually done the lab have tried to hand in a report. Can you believe it? If you know you are going to miss a lab, please email me before the lab.

## Some General Considerations

Be neat. I'll give you blank reports. It's your choice whether you fill out the sheets in the lab or whether you record the data and fill in the sheets later. BUT what you hand in must be neat. All the blank reports are on the website.

I encourage you to use a word processor to write the reports. If you write them by hand, write in ink - no pencil at all. - And use a ruler. Write the report as soon after the lab as possible so things are fresh in your minds.
